Familiares lloran y se lamentan mientras sacan los restos de la furgoneta fúnebre

La familia se abrazó y gritó mientras los auxiliares sacaban pequeños fardos de la furgoneta fúnebre. Los restos estaban tan degradados que una tarjeta escrita a mano identificaba a cada víctima de la secta.

"Nunca pensé ver a mi gente de esta manera. La situación es muy mala,"

dijo Francis Wanje a brasileiro série b palpites .

"Ha sido un viaje muy duro desde el año pasado hasta ahora. Muy duro. Afortunadamente, estoy feliz de haber recuperado a [mis] seres queridos", dijo, después de recibir sus cuerpos.

El martes, Wanje se convirtió en el primer miembro de la familia en recuperar los cuerpos de sus parientes para el entierro después de que se convirtieran en víctimas de una tragedia, denominada matanza de Shakahola, que muchos kenianos tienen dificultades para comprender. En las próximas semanas, las autoridades esperan devolver más cuerpos a las familias.

Los testigos y los fiscales afirman que, a partir de 2024 y durante un período de muchos meses, el carismático pastor Paul Nthenge MacKenzie, un ex conductor de taxi que vivía en Malindi, atrajo a cientos de seguidores al remoto bosque de Shakahola para prepararse para el fin del mundo.

Los funcionarios gubernamentales y los supervivientes afirman que convenció a los seguidores a través del ayuno a muerte para alcanzar la salvación, comenzando con los niños. Las autopsias muestran que la mayoría murió de inanición, mientras que otros fueron agredidos hasta la muerte. En junio del año pasado, se informó sobre cómo las autoridades tardaron en reaccionar a los rumores que salían de la comunidad de la secta.

Ahora un informe oficial condenatorio, publicado este mes por la Comisión Nacional de Derechos Humanos de Kenia (KNCHR), ha puesto de manifiesto un patrón de fallos, retrasos y negligencia en la respuesta del Gobierno que la Comisión afirma que podría haber contribuido significativamente a la espantosa magnitud de la tragedia.

"La Comisión responsabiliza al equipo de seguridad de entonces en Malindi de la grave abdicación de responsabilidad y negligencia", se lee en el informe de 33 páginas. Describe cómo las autoridades no actuaron sobre informes creíbles de las actividades de la secta de varias fuentes, afirmando que podrían haber salvado más vidas.

La Comisión descubrió que la policía ignoró numerosas denuncias presentadas en la estación de policía local, las autoridades ignoraron las advertencias sobre la radicalización en las reuniones y, en un caso, un ex seguidor fue advertido y amonestado después de publicar advertencias específicas sobre el pastor y Shakahola en las redes sociales. En cambio, aceptaron una denuncia del pastor sobre los mensajes en las redes sociales.

En los dos años anteriores a que se retirara con sus seguidores al bosque, MacKenzie había sido detenido en varias ocasiones por sospecha de radicalización.

"La negligencia y el fracaso de las estructuras de seguridad y administración dejaron a los seguidores de MacKenzie a merced y control total de MacKenzie y su milicia", se lee en el informe de la KNCHR.

Kenya's interior cabinet secretary, Kithure Kindiki, has repeatedly apologized for the failures of the government response. Security officers were transferred from the area. Yet promises of more serious penalties have not materialized, despite a government commission of enquiry.

Wanje learned the truth about the cult early last year, when he received a tip that his daughter and her family had moved into the forest with the pastor.

Wanje organized a private rescue mission. When they arrived in the remote forest compound,

they found his oldest grandchild – deeply malnourished and near death. Two of his siblings were already dead.

When **talked to Wanje** last year, he said the boys were suffocated by their parents.

"It's so painful, I could not even explain it because it's something that I didn't even think of in my life," he said.

"And I wonder how my child, my daughter, could change to be such an animal to kill her own children just she wanted to go see Jesus."

Wanje said that his daughter and son-in-law escaped the compound when the rescue team entered, but their bodies were later recovered by the state from the surrounding forest. All in all, Wanje believes eight of their extended family are among the victims. The surviving grandchild is now healthy and in school.

Forensic experts and volunteers have spent months finding and digging up remains of the cult members. So far, authorities say they have found 429 victims.

Of those, only 34 positive DNA matches to surviving family members have been made, said Kenya's chief pathologist, Johansen Oduor.

He said this was because collecting DNA from the remains has been challenging, while family members haven't all been willing to go through with the process, as transporting and burying the bodies can be expensive and many don't want the stigma of collecting former cult members. On Wednesday, the government said those who could not pay would be supported.

Prosecutors finally charged Mackenzie and scores of his senior leadership in January on a series of charges including the murder of 191 children. The pastor and cult leadership have repeatedly denied any wrongdoing.

But the scale of the tragedy is still unclear. Soon the fifth and final phase of exhumations will begin.

It is expected that the death toll could then rise by several hundred, said Irungu Houghton, executive director of Amnesty international in Kenya. "If we put those figures together this single massacre, this mass crime, probably has combined more deaths than several terror attacks we've seen."
